In the pursuit of excellence I am instigating some changes within the staff team and ongoing development of the nursery.

The free flow system is working really well and I congratulate everybody in the over twos team for the work they have done to ensure we keep all rooms open when ever possible. With the completion of the garden we will know use this space as an outside classroom.

From Monday the 7 of June Sam Fords will be responsible for the delivery of practice within the over twos unit. This includes all responsibility for staffing and ensuring planning is delivered to the standard required by Cheeky Monkeys. As a result of this Sam will increase her hours so she work during school holidays.

From immediate effect staff will be allocated a room for a half term and will have responsibility for the practice within that room for half a term.
